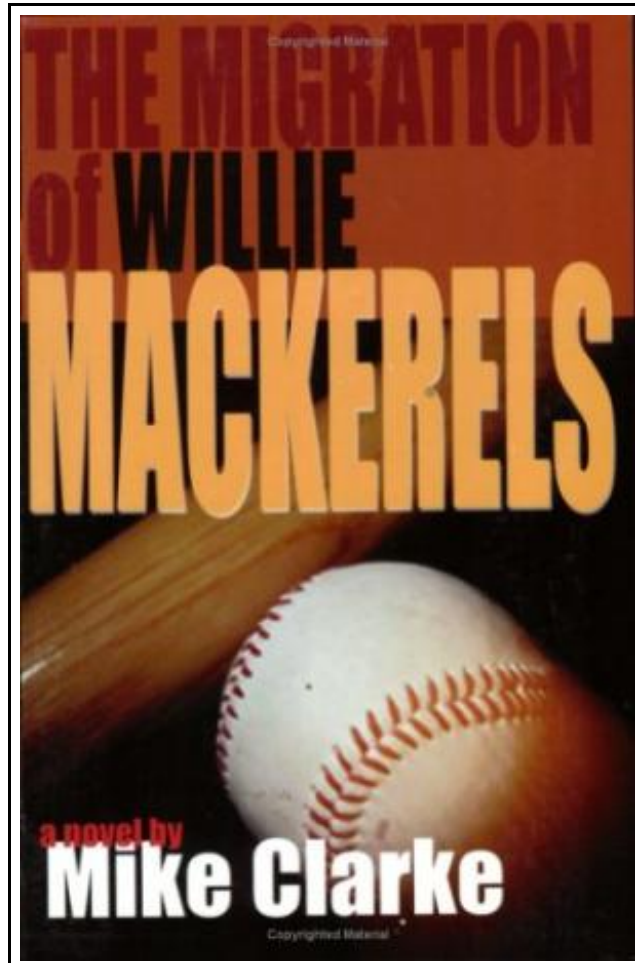

Willie moves away when his parents purchase a rundown tavern on the Olympic Peninsula, the most wild and remote area in the State of Washington. Now in his senior year of high school, Willie plays football, basketball and baseball for the perennial doormat of the league, the Happy Valley Milk Maids. The Milk Maids lose game after game and seem incapable of beating anyone, let alone the powerful Scandia Vikings, led by his old rival, Teddy Snodgrass. But Willie won't give up. He has a secret baseball weapon- taught to him by the town drunk. It just might be enough to upset the Vikings and recapture the attention of the lovely Trudy. Mike Clarke has written two previous novels that centre around the theme of fishing.
