

Lile, of the law department, had been commissioned by the university to receive the picture, and he did so in an exceedingly adroit and skillful speech, in which he attempted a reconciliation of the views of Marshall and Jefferson. These speeches will be published in a pamphlet, which will also contain some account of the portrait itself.
