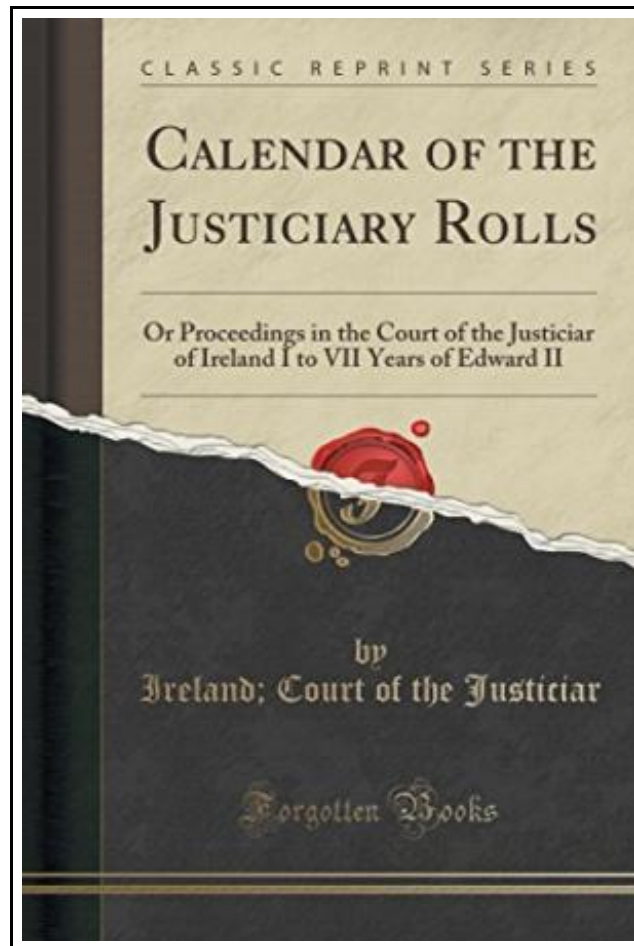

Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Excerpt from Calendar of the Justiciary Rolls: Or Proceedings in the Court of the Justiciar of Ireland I to VII Years of Edward II When the publication of a calendar to the Justiciary Rolls of Ireland was originally undertaken, it was intended that the whole of this series of rolls, extending to the eighteenth year of Richard II, should be included. By 1922, when all but one of the original rolls perished in the destruction of the Public Record office, only two volumes, covering the years 1295 to 1307, had been made, but had not been finally revised. Now that the originals, excepting the roll for 6 and 7 Edward II, no longer exist, these calendars have become of primary importance despite their unfinished condition, and it has therefore been decided to undertake their publication. The present volume covers the following rolls: - 1. Roll for 1 and 2 Edward II. This was made up into four rolls, listed by the Record Commissioners as plea rolls nos. 84 (containing mm. 1-20), 85 (mm. 21-37), 86 (mm. 38-64) and 87 (mm. 65-79). The calendar, made by Herbert Wood, late Deputy Keeper, covers nos. 85 (mm. 29-36), 86 (mm. 45-50 and 52-65) and 87 (mm. 65-79). Mm. 1-20, which ran from 13 Oct. 1307, do not appear in the catalogue of Justiciary Rolls in the Deputy Keeper's 26th report, and do not seem to have reached the Public Record Office. 2.
