

The margins of the body are almost parallel for the greater part of their length, tapering gently to the more pointed anterior end and abruptly to form the obtusely rounded posterior end. As in most species of this genus the body is convex dorsally and flat or slightly concave ventrally. The subterminal mouth is surrounded by a weakly developed sucking musculature which measures 115/i in diameter. This leads to the spherical or slightly elongated pharynx, measuring 115 to 264/i in width by 115 to 298/i in length. Following this the slender esophagus, 500 to 750/i in length, leads to the intestinal bifurcation. The crura are quite variable in size as well as in the character of the median wall. In some cases they show a tendency to the formation of internal ceca; these appear to be due to the...
